10 points ... **PRESENTATION**

10 points ... **ORAL REPORT**

Be sure to practice your presentation and how you will use your symbols ahead of time. Keep your report to about 3 minutes. Speak using a loud, clear, and enthusiastic voice. You may wish to write a few notes on a piece of paper so you remember everything you want to share! **Please no reading of the entire report.**
