

THIRD GRADE RULES, REWARDS and CONSEQUENCES

CLASS RULES

Corpus Christi School has implemented a school wide program called Discipline with Purpose. The objective of the program is to build life skills in listening, organization, respect and cooperation. Students are given the opportunity to practice self discipline. Each grade will have the following 3 rules:

1. Respect Yourself, Others and Things
2. Contribute to the Learning Environment
3. Follow School and Classroom Procedures

Through the program, students will learn and practice 15 self discipline skills from Kindergarten through 8th grade. Please consult the handbook for more detail.

CLASS REWARDS

Providing a positive environment is important for the self esteem of each child. Students are verbally praised for good deeds accomplished, trying their best, and doing well both socially and academically. Class Rewards will be given for positive group interaction and cooperation.

CONSEQUENCES

Because each student must be responsible for his or her own actions, it is important to have classroom consequences for students who forget to choose to follow our classroom and school rules. The consequences are as follows:

1. First time: Cue or Verbal Warning. The student will have the opportunity to self correct their behavior.
2. Second time: Student will be reminded about classroom expectations.
3. Third time: Student will be required to write down which rule they broke on a hand. If they receive 5 or more hands in one week, a letter and the hands will be sent home. If necessary, a conference with the parents, student and teacher will be arranged.
