Principal's Report: Katie Murphy, Principal

- Mission effectiveness: Standards 8, 9, 10, 11, 12 & 13 were reviewed & discussed.
- School received money from 8th grade families to replace desks 7th grade and any extra will go towards 6th grade.
- 8th grade teacher opening filled by Keilla Mata, a credentialed teacher from a Catholic school in southern Cal. The 2nd grade teacher filled by Stephanie Quillici a credentialed teacher. The Kindergarten teacher opening has been filled by Cortney Fuerch, a Corpus graduate and parishioner and was on staff at St. Theresa's.
- Both K aides are leaving as they both finished their credentialing. The 2 aides will be replaced by 1 aide with supplemental internal help.
- There is an opening for the 5th grade teacher.
- Adrianne Bright the librarian is leaving and Sue Scott is filling the role; she is a parishioner and volunteered in the library when her daughter attended Corpus.
- Approval received from Diocese to remodel the 4 remaining classrooms (1st through 4th grades) and corridor in the 2016/17 summer with understanding that monies will be kept with Diocese.
- Funds received from the Parent's Group in the amount of \$46,000 from the Walkathon to go towards tuition assistance and remodeling. The Parent's Group also increased their TIP contribution from \$3,000 to \$5,000 and also contributed towards first aid/CPR training of both staff and students, another Mobile ipad lab, speakers in the 5th through



8th grade classrooms, a new school camera and additional funds for tuition assistance. We also received the \$70,000 for operational budget.
