Dear Kindergarten Student,

Welcome to Kindergarten! My name is Mrs. Linda Halkias and I will be your teacher. We have a fun and exciting year planned for all and I look forward to greeting you on August 25th.

Before school begins there are a few items you will need for the first day.

DO NOT PUT YOUR CHILD'S NAME ON THESE 5 ITEMS.

- 1 dozen No. 2 pencils (ordinary "yellow" pencils only)
- 6-LARGE glue sticks (Elmer's is best)
- 1-LARGE box of tissues
- 1-container Clorox disinfectant surface wipes (35 count)
- 1- small bottle hand sanitizer

PLEASE LABEL THE FOLLOWING SUPPLIES WITH YOUR CHILD'S FIRST AND LAST NAME AND WHAT SESSION THEY ARE IN- AM OR PM.

Backpack (sturdy, large enough to accommodate folders)

NO ROLLING BACKPACKS PLEASE

- 1- folder with pockets (ANY KIND)
- 1- water color paint set (small box, primary colors/no pastels)
- 1- box of crayons (8 ONLY- PRIMARY COLORS)
- 1- box of large washable markers (8 ONLY - PRIMARY COLORS)
- 1- pair of safety scissors (Fiskars are the best)
- 1 set of colored pencils (12 count)

Some items may need to be replaced during the school year. Please check with your child often to see what supplies may be needed.

First Grade Supplies

The following will be collected for classroom use:

- 1 dozen No. 2 pencils (ordinary "yellow" pencils only please)
- 1 package eraser caps for pencils

- 1 large box Kleenex tissues

These are sent home weekly for cleaning/washing

- 1 vinyl tablecloth desk covering for lunch (approximately 24" x 28")
- 1 cleaning rag (an old washcloth is great)

- 1 set alphabetizer cards (indexed for recipe box)
- 2 packages index cards (3x5 size) plain

- 1 set watercolor paints with brush
- 1 12-inch ruler (with centimeter markings)

- 3 plastic folders with pockets (includes one for Spanish)
- 4 spiral bound notebooks (8 1/2 x 11) at least 100 sheets each

- 1 letter-size clipboard

Please label and store these in a storage box : 11" x 6.5"

- 1 set of assorted washable markers
 - 1 set of colored pencils
 - 1 small bottle Elmer's glue (4 ounces)
 - 1 box crayons (up to 64 count)
- 1 pair safety scissors (Fiskars preferred)

Second Grade Supplies

In order to be prepared for school in the fall please purchase all the items listed below. Please be sure to label them with your child's name.

- 1 box of 24 crayons
- 1 set of broad tip colored markers
- 2 glue sticks
- 1 pair of scissors with a sharp point
- 2 erasers with name on them
- 1 watercolor paint set (last year's is fine)
- 1 pencil box (approximately 8.5"x6"x2.5") - larger boxes won't fit in the desk.
- 2 notebooks - 100 pages each; wide-ruled (non-spiral binding is best)
- 1 folder with pockets labeled "Take Home"
- 1 folder with pockets labeled "School"
- 1 plastic ruler with inches and centimeters
- 1 box of colored pencils
- 1 box of 12-16 oil pastels
- 1 clipboard for 8.5x11" paper
- 1 small pencil sharpener with a compartment for shavings
- 1 old shirt or smock for art with name on it
- 1 dozen good quality, (yellow only)#2 pencils *
- 1 4 oz. bottle of Elmer's Glue *
- 2 boxes of hand/baby wipes *
- 2 boxes of facial tissue *
- 1 package of stickers *

Do not buy a binder or "trapper keeper" as they do not fit into the desks.

- These items will be shared as a class, so you do not need to label them with your name.
